SUBJECT	Request approval to supersede 70 Legal Entity (LE) Agreements for mental health services Fiscal Years 2012-13 and 2013-14.

COST & FUNDING	The FY 2012-13 annual MCA for each LE Agreement totals \$387,396,733 and is based on the amounts contained in DMH's Recommended Budget for FY 2012-13 funded from the following sources: State Mental Health Services Act (MHSA) Revenue in the amount of \$81,034,661; Federal Revenues in the amount of \$168,793,995; Intrafund Transfers in the amount of \$9,026,970; and Net County Cost (NCC)/Sales Tax Realignment in the amount of \$128,541,107.
PURPOSE OF REQUEST	Board approval of this action is necessary to ensure the uniformity of terms and conditions in all DMH LE Agreements by allowing DMH to supersede those 70 LE Agreements with one-year or two-year term remaining, with a LE Agreement that includes all new and revised provisions. In addition, these LE Agreements will have revised Maximum Contract Amounts due to the implementation and expansion of Mental Health Services Act Prevention and Early Intervention programs across all age groups including Adult and Older Adult

As mandated by your Board, each Contractor's performance is evaluated by DMH on an annual basis to ensure compliance with all contract terms and performance standards.</p> <p>These LE Agreements will allow for continued and uninterrupted mental health services to existing mental health clients throughout Los Angeles County.</p> <p>By superseding these LE Agreements with the new DMH LE agreement format, each existing Contractor will be contractually obligated to comply with all new and revised provisions to the LE Agreement, as well as to continue providing essential and accessible mental health services to clients throughout Los Angeles County.</p>
