Val Zavala is Vice President of News and Public Affairs at KCET, the west coast flagship station for PBS. She is also the anchor of KCET's weekly award-winning newsmagazine, SoCal Connected. She has been at KCET since 1987, playing a vital role in the long-running newsmagazine, Life & Times, as well as other news programs and specials. Her work has won 14 L.A. Area Emmys, eight Golden Mikes and numerous L.A. Press Club awards.

Ms. Zavala has been honored by numerous community organizations including the California Chicano News Media Association (2009 gala), and Hispanic Americans for Fairness in Media for integrity and longevity in the field of television journalism (2006). She was named one of the 100 most influential Latinas by Hispanic Business Magazine in 2006. She was a Senior Fellow for UCLA's School of Public Affairs (2007-08).

In 1992, Ms. Zavala was selected for a John S. Knight Fellowship at Stanford University, a prestigious mid-career program for journalists. She received her Masters in journalism from American University in Washington, D. C. and her B.A. in Latin American Studies from Yale University.
