**Clinical Psychologist II – MHSA Implementation Unit
MHSA Outcomes**

The MHSA Implementation Unit is seeking a Clinical Psychologist II for the purposes of the development and production of MHSA program outcomes, analysis of data and reports with concentrations on Prevention and Early Intervention (PEI) and Innovation. The MHSA Innovation Plan seeks to compare 4 models that provide or link clients to integrated health, mental health and substance abuse services.

The MHSA Innovation Plan is unique in the sense that its primary purpose is to facilitate learning. Thus, outcomes across the 4 Innovation models include:

- The degree of service integration of health, mental health and substance abuse.
- The health, mental health and substance use status of clients participating in the model programs.
- Consumer and community satisfaction with integrated services.
- Cost effectiveness of each model.

Duties will include but are not limited to:

- Collect, analyze and report on data from each of the provider sites.
- Prepare reports to the State on the status of Innovation implementation and learning.
- Lead quarterly data-informed learning meetings with all Innovation providers and Innovation model lead staff.
- Make recommendations on program mid-course corrections, as necessary, based on a review of the learning and data analysis.

Duties related to the MHSA PEI program include collecting, analyzing and reporting on pre and post treatment outcome data for each PEI practice as well as working with developers and MHSA program leads on the overall implementation of these practices.

Desirable qualifications include:

- Strong data analytic skills.
- Strong interpersonal skills, including the ability to train and provide technical assistance to providers and Department staff of the use of outcome measures and reports.
- Strong writing skills.
- Familiarity with evidence-based practices.
- Familiarity with outcomes data collection and analysis.
- Proficient in the creation and use of databases such as Microsoft Access and Excel.
- Strong ability to utilize data to assist providers in achieving goals.
